



Poncho Pattern (With Hood)

Size: Suitable for 1 year old

Materials

- 3-ply baby yarn
- 4 mm circular knitting needles
- Stitch marker
- Pom-pom maker
- 2.5 mm crochet hook

Hood (Beanie Shape)

Cast on **85 stitches**.

Row 1

~~Knit~~ **Knit** the row.

Front (Right Side)

Work **seed stitch**:

- Knit the stitches that appear purl,
- Purl the stitches that appear knit.

After knitting **3 stitches**, work **1 popcorn stitch** into the **4th stitch**.

Popcorn Stitch (Crochet)

- Insert the crochet hook into the stitch space and chain 3.
- Work **4–5 double crochets** into the same space, leaving each stitch unfinished (keep loops on the hook).
- When there are **5 loops** on the hook, yarn over and pull through all loops at once to close.
- Fasten off and transfer the loop back onto the knitting needle.

Continue with **5 stitches in seed stitch**, then work another popcorn stitch. Repeat this sequence across the row, with **5 seed stitches between each popcorn stitch**.

Back (Wrong Side)

Work all stitches in **seed stitch**.

Continue working both front and back rows in **seed stitch**.

Next Front Row

- 6 seed stitches
- 1 popcorn stitch
- 5 seed stitches

- 1 popcorn stitch
- 5 seed stitches Repeat to the end of the row.

Work **3 rows** in seed stitch.

Next Front Row

Repeat the **1st popcorn row**.

Work **3rows** in seed stitch.

Next Front Row

Repeat the **2nd popcorn row**.

You will have worked **4 popcorn rows in total**.

Afterwards, continue knitting all stitches in **seed stitch** until the piece measures **18 cm**.

Bind off all stitches. Fold and seam to form a **beanie shape**, completing the **hood**.

Poncho Body

From the bottom edge of the hood, **pick up 80 stitches**.

Row 1

Knit all stitches in **garter stitch**.

Front (Right Side)

- 8 garter stitches
- *Yarnover(increase),knit2together (decrease), 3 garter stitches* Repeat to the end of the row. Finish with **8 garter stitches**.

You should still have **80 stitches**.

Back (Wrong Side)

Knit all stitches in **garter stitch**.

Work **1moregarter ridge**.

Next Front Row

- 8 garter stitches
- 1 increase
- 24 stitches in seed stitch
- 1 increase
- 16 knit stitches
- 1 increase
- 24 stitches in seed stitch
- 1 increase
- 8 garter stitches

Next Back Row

- 8 garter stitches

- 26 stitches in seed stitch
- 16 purl stitches
- 26 stitches in seed stitch
- 8 garter stitches

Next Front Row

- 8 garter stitches
- 1 increase
- 26 seed stitches
- 1 increase
- 16 knit stitches
- 1 increase
- 26 seed stitches
- 1 increase
- 8 garter stitches

Next Back Row

- 8 garter stitches
- 28 seed stitches
- 16 purl stitches
- 28 seed stitches
- 8 garter stitches

Continue increasing in this manner until there are **11 garter ridges** on each edge.

Joining & Body Length

Join the work using the circular needle and begin knitting in the round.

- The center section will have **16 garter ridges**.
- The edge garter stitches are now knitted as **knit stitches**.

Work as follows:

- One round: make increases on both sides of the **16 knit-stitch section**.
- Next round: knit the knit stitches as knit, seed stitches as seed stitch (no increases).

Continue this pattern until the poncho measures **28 cm** from the joining row.

Popcorn Decoration

After reaching the length, work **popcorn stitches** as done in the hood:

- Place popcorn stitches with **5 stitches between them**, including along the edges.
- Work **4 popcorn rows** in total.

Tie Cord

For the tie:

- Chain a cord to the desired length.
- Attach **one popcorn motif** to each end.

- Thread the cord through the holes at the neckline and secure.

Your poncho is now complete!
